Students are required to complete approximately 8 hours of self-paced online pre-course work prior to the first day of class. The 10-week course of instruction will begin Monday January 29, 2025, with one week of classroom instruction followed by one week of facilitated distance learning. Students will have a two week break prior to the next two weeks of instruction. The course schedule is:

- January 27 - 31, 2025 - Retreat
- February 3 - 7, 2025 - Distance Learning
- March 3 - 7, 2025 - Distance Learning
- March 10 - 14, 2025 - Classroom Learning
- April 8 - 12, 2025 - Distance Learning
- April 15 - 19, 2025- Classroom Learning
- May 5 - 9, 2025 - Distance Learning
- May 12 - 16, 2025 - Classroom Learning
- June 2 - 6, 2025 - Distance Learning
- June 9 - 13, 2025 - Classroom Learning
